The Aboriginal Leadership Group (ALG) held its 21st meeting which focused on reviewing progress, identifying priorities, and ensuring community voices guide decisions that improve safety, wellbeing, and connectivity across Central Australia.

Apmere Mwerre Visitors Park (AMVP) Expansion

The ALG acknowledged the successful opening of the AMVP expansion, operated by Aboriginal Hostels Limited, on Tuesday, 11 November 2025.

The expansion delivers 20 additional beds, providing safe and affordable accommodation for First Nations people, including women and children experiencing family and domestic violence. Members' advice played an important role in shaping this outcome, which strengthens community accommodation and support services.
