



Communiqué: Aboriginal Leadership Group

Meeting 23: Wednesday 8 April and Thursday 9 April 2026

The Aboriginal Leadership Group (ALG) convened its 23rd meeting on 8-9 April 2026 to review progress, provide advice, and endorse key governance and delivery arrangements to support implementation of the Central Australia Plan (CAP) and improved outcomes for communities across Central Australia.

Key Outcomes

- **CAP Implementation**
The ALG received updates on progress across key CAP priority areas since the February 2026 meeting, including implementation tracking, investment by cluster, and the communications strategy.
 - **Initiative Updates**
Members received updates and discussed key initiatives aimed at improving outcomes across Central Australia. These included sessions on:
 - Community Infrastructure Package
 - Employment and Training
 - Northern Territory Remote Aboriginal Investment (NTRAI)
 - NT Police updates on recent activity in Central Australia.
 - **Strengthening Governance**
The Group also reviewed and endorsed the '*Doing Things Differently*' guideline, which outlines the principles, commitments, and practical actions to work in genuine partnership. Members also provided advice on the future direction of the Youth Roundtable, discussing alternative options that continue to see youth perspectives captured and fed into decision-making.
