Membership & Warehouse Accounts - Access to low cost food relief

Foodbank SA & NT's offer free membership to Remote Communities for independent or Community run stores. This free membership provides access to ordering of low cost staple food and groceries including; pantry food, meat, frozen goods, personal hygiene products, household cleaning products and free fruit and vegetables (subject to availability). Orders are placed online and available for collection at the nearest Foodbank warehouse. Foodbank are also happy to discuss the support in identifying freight arrangements for delivery. Food Hub Referral - A dignified shopping experience for those in need

The Foodbank Food Hubs provide a dignified shopping experience, providing food relief to those experiencing food insecurity direct via our 12 Food Hubs and 3 Mobile Food Hubs operating in metro, regional and remote regions. Those accessing the service must be referred by a member organisation. Community organisations and Councils can become referrers into the Food Hub service when they become Foodbank members. School Breakfast Program - Feeding children in our communities

Foodbank SA & NT is the largest provider of School Breakfast Programs in the Northern Territory. Foodbank SA & NT helps ensure that no child starts their day on an empty stomach. By delivering healthy food and fresh fruit to schools, the Program empowers students in need to focus, learn, and thrive at school.

Schools registered for the Foodbank SA & NT School Breakfast Program receive free healthy breakfast supplies, and free delivery is provided to remote and very remote schools across the Northern Territory. The range of food includes cereal (e.g. Weetbix/oats), long-life milk, powdered milk, canned fruit, fresh fruit, Vegemite, jam, baked beans, tin spaghetti, bread, and flour. 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Cultural Event Support

Foodbank work with the community to identify culturally appropriate food for the different cultural groups we support, this includes sourcing food such as lentils, pulses and Kangaroo. Foodbank also provide support during Cultural events and Sorry Business (Foodbank have developed a Sorry Business Fund to support in times of grieving). Disaster Relief, preparedness & Food Lockers

Foodbank is the primary provider of food relief during disasters in South Australia and the Northern Territory. This includes responding to floods, fires, cyclones, the wet season and drought affected communities. Our work includes the support with Disaster preparedness in community to mitigate the risks of food insecurity at times of disaster. Communities at risk of the impacts of disaster may qualify for a Food Locker (containers of food relief to be placed in community prior to the wet season and accessed at time of disaster or preparedness support).



New Community Food Hubs - Community Stores

Foodbank support the development of Community Food Hubs to empower communities to run their own food relief operations, previous support has included Dunjiba Community Council with the Oodnadatta Food Hub and the support of the establishment of the Raukkan Community Store. Foodbank support can include the establishment support with accessing funding arrangements, set up and ongoing operations.
