DETERMINATION

WHEREAS it is provided by sub-section 7(1A) of the Aboriginal Land Rights (Northern Territory) Act 1976 that where, on the application, in writing, of the Land Council for the area in which the land to be held by a Land Trust established, or about to be established, under section 4, is situated, being an application made after the commencement of this sub-section and before any person is appointed to be a member of that Land Trust, the Minister is satisfied that it is appropriate so to do, the Minister may, by writing under his hand, make, in respect of the Land Trust -

- (a) a determination that the Land Trust shall not have a Chairman but shall consist of such number of members, not being less than 3, as the Minister specifies in the determination; or
- (b) a determination that the Land Trust shall consist of a Chairman and 2 other members,

and, where a determination is so made in relation to a Land Trust, the Land Trust shall be constituted in accordance with the determination:

AND WHEREAS the Northern Land Council has applied in writing that the Finniss River Aboriginal Land Trust not have a Chairman, but consist of 8 members;

AND WHEREAS I am satisfied that it is appropriate to so determine;

NOW THEREFORE I, ROBERT EDWARD TICKNER, Minister of State for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Affairs, pursuant to sub-section 7(1A) of the Aboriginal Land Rights (Northern Territory) Act 1976, hereby determine that the Finniss River Aboriginal Land Trust shall not have a Chairman but shall consist of 8 members.

On 15 November 2013, Senator the Hon Nigel Scullion, Minister for Indigenous Affairs, acting under section 76 of the *Aboriginal Land Rights (Northern Territory) Act 1976* (the Act), delegated certain functions and powers in respect of sections 7 and 9 of the Act. Refer to <u>Attachment A</u>.

You therefore have the power to appoint Land Trust members, under section 7 of the Act, on receipt of nominations from the relevant Land Council.

Members appointed by the Minister or an authorised delegate are appointed as part-time members, under subsection 7(4) of the Act. Under subsection 7(6) of the Act, members of a Land Trust shall be Aboriginals living in the area of the Land Council in which the Land Trust is situated or whose names are set out in the register maintained by the Land Council in accordance with section 24 of the Act.

Under subsection 7(7) of the Act, a member of a Land Trust holds office for such period, not exceeding five years, as is specified in the instrument of appointment and on such terms and conditions as the Minister determines, but is eligible for re-appointment.

Section 77 of the Act makes provision for remuneration and allowances applicable to members of Land Trusts.

Issues

Finnis River Aboriginal Land Trust

Nominations for the appointment of a Chair and members to the Finnis Aboriginal Land Trust were sent to the Minister by the Northern Land Council in correspondence dated 17 November 2014 (refer to C14/94481 attached).

Previous appointments to the Land Trust expired on 23 February 2014.

Subject to you appointing members to the Finniss River Aboriginal Land Trust in this instance:

- The signed and dated Instrument of Appointment will be forwarded to the Land Council with a covering letter signed by the Senior Adviser of the Northern Territory Office Land Section.
- Correspondence to the new members, advising of their appointment to the Land Trust, will also be signed by the Senior Adviser of the Northern Territory Office Land Section and forwarded care of the Land Council, unless an alternative postal address for the member has been provided.
