- **Recommendation 8 of the 2018 Regional Telecommunications Review** – Getting it right out there and Australian Government in-principle agreement Recommendation 8 that called for a targeted Indigenous Digital Inclusion Program, with a focus on access, affordability and digital ability, to be developed in partnership with Indigenous communities.
- **Target 17 of the National Agreement on Closing the Gap** - That includes digital inclusion as part of the Access to Information target (Target 17) – developed through a partnership between Australian governments and the Coalition of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peak Organisations. It includes digital inclusion as part of the Access to Information target – by 2026, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people have equal levels of digital inclusion.
