Explanatory Notes

This report has been prepared on the following basis.

- 'Legal services expenditure' has been defined as legal services accrued by the National Indigenous Australians Agency during the 2022-23 financial year.
- 'Internal legal services' have been identified in accordance with the definition used by the Australian
 National Audit Office in Audit Report No. 52 of 2004-05. Activities of the department coming within the
 ANAO definition of 'internal legal services' may also involve the provision of policy advice, so internal legal
 services are not necessarily directly comparable with, or able to be substituted by, external legal services.
- In considering the Agency's internal legal services expenditure, relevant managers estimated the percentage of time spent by legally qualified staff on legal work. Approximate totals were derived using base salaries, and include an estimate of overheads.
